Marines Code of Conduct:

All coaches and support people within this club are volunteers. It is important that players and parents adhere to our code of conduct. Please read the conditions before registering online.

- 1. I agree to respect Marines Netball Club's good name and play in a manner that is fair and of good sportsmanship. Everyone within the club shows respect for everyone else, players, parents, coaches, umpires.
- 2. Verbal or physical abuse of officials or any other player will not be tolerated. Membership may be revoked if deemed necessary by the Committee.
- 3. Being a member of the Marines Netball Club is a privilege, not a right, and membership should be valued accordingly.
- 4. I, or members of my support group, will not dispute umpiring decisions whilst playing.
- 5. I will assist with Club Fundraising and attend meetings when required.
- 6. I will abide by the Marines Netball dress code. I will buy a uniform as required by the club and will not alter the dress after purchase. For training, I will come in proper attire sports shoes, tracksuits, shorts, or skirts.
- 7. Whilst wearing the Marines Netball Club uniform on or off the court, and in any public setting, I am representing the club. Any ill behaviour that misrepresents the club may result in termination of my membership if deemed necessary by the Committee.
- 8. All players must make sure before each game that their nails have been cut and all jewellery to be removed prior to training and games.
- 9. Teams in 2024 will be selected on ability and balance within the team. Efforts are made to keep age groups and friends together but this is not always possible.
- 10. I will pay my Club fees, including MNA fees by the due date. Failure to do so will result in exclusion from playing for Marines Netball Club. Umpiring fees are payable per player, per competition. If you play Saturdays and Mondays you are liable for two umpire payments.
- 11. Players are required to be at their games at least 20 minutes before the start of their game. Getting to the game on time is the responsibility of both player and parents.
- 12. Players must notify their coaches if they are unable to attend training or make a game. Notice must be given at least 24 hours prior to the game, unless very ill.
- 13. Training is held at the Thomson Street Courts. Coaches will allocate time and day for training. I understand that if I do not train, I shall not be guaranteed equal court time during games.
- 14. By registering with the Marines Netball Club, I agree to adhere to the code of conduct, and make a commitment to myself, my team and my club, to be the best I can.

If you feel that you cannot do this, then perhaps the Marines Netball Club is not the club for you. By registering with Marines Netball Club, I agree to abide by the above conditions.

SOCIAL MEDIA AND PHOTOGRAPHY CODE

Marines Netball Club recognises the need to ensure the welfare and safety of all young people in sport. At times, photographs of our members participating in netball based activities may be taken. Parental permission can be revoked at any time with written notice.

All posts to social media on either Facebook, Twitter or Instagram relating to any player, coach, committee member or umpire, must be of a positive nature. Any participation in vexatious or abusive behaviour may result in your expulsion from Marines Netball Club.
